| How do AutoNation, Inc. owned dealerships<br>protect my personal information? | To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and<br>use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These<br>measures include computer safeguards and secured files and<br>buildings. Our employees are also bound by our policies to access<br>your personal information only for legitimate business purposes and<br>to keep information about you confidential.   |  |
| How do AutoNation, Inc. owned dealerships<br>collect my personal information? | <ul> <li>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</li> <li>apply for financing</li> <li>apply for a lease</li> <li>give us your contact information</li> <li>give us your employment information</li> <li>show your driver's license</li> <li>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</li> </ul>  |  |
| Why can't I limit all sharing?  | <ul> <li>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</li> <li>sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> <li>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. | Definitions     |   |  |

| Affiliates      | <ul> <li>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>Our affiliates include companies within the AutoNation, Inc. family of companies, such as dealerships and nonfinancial companies.</li> </ul>  |  |
| Nonaffiliates   | <ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>Nonaffiliates we share with can include government entities and credit reporting agencies. We may also disclose information to nonaffiliates in response to a subpoena or court order, as required by certain federal and state laws, to help complete a transaction initiated by you and pursuant to your request or authorization.</li> </ul> |  |
| Joint marketing | <ul> <li>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</li> <li>Our joint marketing partners include financial institutions, such as the financing affiliates of motor vehicle manufacturers and financial product or service marketing companies.</li> </ul>  |  |

## Other important information

You may have other privacy protections under some state laws. We will comply with applicable state laws as to information about you, including medical information.

- Accounts with California or Vermont addresses will be treated as if you opted out of joint marketing arrangements.
- Accounts with Vermont addresses will be treated as if you opted out of sharing information among our affiliates.
